

COLLEGE EXPERIENCE CAMP

In addition to technical softball training there will be sessions on speed and power development; mental training; and exposure to specially designed, interactive university academic classes. Campers will benefit from an opportunity to train in the same environment that produced four NAIA national championship softball teams, nine NAIA regional championships in the past 14 years, and also helped develop eleven SFU athletes who have gone on to compete in the Olympic Games. Camp instruction is by SFU head coach and former Olympic coach Mike Renney and a staff of current and former athletes.

This concept camp is based upon providing participants with a week-long college experience. Giving them the opportunity to experience college life, using varsity athletic facilities and receiving college caliber training. While the camp's focus is on elite development, it will also be about the experience that one can only get by going to University high atop Burnaby Mountain on the SFU campus.

This camp includes lunch and an afternoon snack each day.

Due to renovations with the campus residences there is no availability for accommodations. Therefore, we will not be hosting a LIVE - IN option this year. Sorry for the inconvenience, we do plan to host a Live-In option in the summer of 2011.
