**What is Learn to Play?**

Learn to Play consists of 3 levels of a great, safe introduction to the game of softball with mush balls and qualified leaders. Children advance through the 3 levels of skill development while having fun with their friends. Developed for children age 5 thru 10 Learn to Play is emerging across Canada as a revolutionary way to ensure that children have FUN while improving their fitness and developing their softball skills. Learn to Play is ACTION packed and fosters SUCCESS for all ability levels.

**Level 1 Learn to Play \$75 boys and girls born in 2005 and 2006**

Season runs April 27 to June 15. The fee includes the team and individual photo, insurance, a team shirt to keep, weekly treat, awards for all participants and a closing party at Squint Lake Park with hot dogs and drinks for everyone. Camps are held Wednesday nights 6:30 - 7:30pm at Wesburn Park in the South and Squint Lake Park in the north. All you need to provide is a softball glove. Camps are conducted by qualified, trained, enthusiastic instructors.

**Level 2 T-Ball \$100 boys and girls born in 2003 and 2004**

Eight weeks of fun from late April to June 16th, two nights a week. Fee includes team and individual photo, insurance, awards for all players and a closing party with hot dogs and drinks for everyone at Squint Lake Park on Saturday, June 18th. Games are played on Tuesday and Thursday nights 6:30-8:00pm at a park or school in your area. The coach pitches three balls to the child and if they haven't got a hit, the tee is used. Emphasis is on having fun and developing the basic softball skills of catching, throwing and hitting. Everyone is a winner! Uniforms are provided. Your child will need a glove and a softball approved helmet. **Parent coach volunteers are needed. We provide training and support.**

**Level 3 Mite Softball \$100 boys and girls born in 2001 and 2002**

Boys teams and girls teams are formed individually if registration permits otherwise co-ed teams are formed. Games are played twice a week on Mondays and Wednesday 6:30-8:00pm mid April - June 19th Saturday closing at Squint Lake Park. Team and individual photo, insurance, awards and the closing party are all included in the fee. Uniforms are also provided. Emphasis continues on having fun and developing skills while ensuring that each child experiences success and is gradually introduced to a competitive environment. Your child will need a glove and a softball approved helmet. **Parent coach volunteers are needed. We provide training and support.**
